TECHNICAL SCHOOL OF WORKS

Chuo Cha Ufundi

For the experience, made in Chakama in these 10 years, I realized that for most young people living in rural areas it is practically impossible to start university studies. The main problem is the economic factor.

As a result, they find themselves educated at 18 but without the knowledge necessary to get a job.

Therefore, we have decided to include in our educational project the creation of a school which, immediately after the Primary, offers the students technical lessons to learn seriously to work in the various commercial and industrial sectors and enter the world of work.

We will start with four courses, the most useful and practical ones:

- Mason-painter
- Plumber
- Electrician
- Farmer

while to follow we will start:

- Computer Technology
- Mechanics / Driver
- Taylor
- Restaurant and Hotel services
- Carpenter

The school is dedicated to facilitate young learning and getting the job they prefer as soon as they learn.

The theory will be taught from Monday to Thursday while Friday and Saturday the students will be assistant Example:

Those who choose NURSE will be hospital assistant on Friday and Saturday while those who choose TAILOR will be a tailor's assistant and so on, the same for all other courses.

Karibu will provide the structure for theoretical courses in Kibora farm Center and will offer free accommodation for totally 24 students. They are only requested to pay boarding materials, accessories and food. Karibu will provide also the various agreements with each partner involved for practice.

At the end of the courses students will receive our certification with special note of all teachers and partners.

The duration of the courses varies according to the courses

All courses are continuous with one month break between the end and the beginning of the new course.

We will open one SERVICES OFFICES in MALINDI to give job to all our student

TILAPIA PROJECT

It consists in the purchase of a land already identified, to build a small lake using the waters of the GALANA River, both in and out.

Tilapia has a high rhythm of both reproduction and egg quantity. This will ensure enough food for the community and trade with all the neighboring towns to Malindi. Also shrimp and small river fish.

The system consists of:

- Pipeline for running from river to lake and vice versa with control trap for drainage and water cleaning
- Pump to facilitate the flow of water from the river to the lake
- Small cabin for pump control and operation

Maternity and elderly care project

The final act of the project that starts with childhood and closes with the assistance of the elderly.


The elderly, alone, poor and sick. In summary, a Resting House where they will be assisted with love and attention until their death. In particular, it will be of assistance to all terminal patients trying to make their last years of life less difficult.

But to give the very meaning of the endless cycle of our lives, an area will be reserved for those who will be carefully assisted in the special, unique and wonderful moment of childbirth.

The property is made up of many small, two-person cottages, scattered in the small grove close to the lake and all connected to the Direction and Reception Center.

All this is free and subsidized by KARIBU ONLUS with the support of any donors.

The initial cottages will be 8 to accommodate 16 elderly and will reach 24 in the next 5 years


COMMUNITY HALL

AGORA has always been the center of the polis, the city, a living nucleus.

The sacred place for religious functions, the political site, the place of the encounter, the place where a community recognizes itself, the place where a community grows, with its rites, its laws, with its continuous live. And it governs.

KIBORA is no exception, this is why the need for this vital structure.

The KIBORA Agora will be in the shape of a shell and will be called KUBWA KAURI, the Great Shell, a sort of maternal womb for all its present and future children, to any ethnicity they belong to.



The structure will be underground for 2.00 meters, surrounded by staircases and a large stage will be built at the southern end.

The cover will be supported by large wooden beams of casuarina specially treated and made entirely in MAKUTI, the characteristic roof of Kenya.

1. **Aloe scabrifolia** - This is a sprawling species, with stems up to 120 cms. It branches from the base to form clubs of 3 cm in diameter, the leaves are born in loose rosette. Are erect to spreading and often recurved. The inflorescence is up to 1 metre tall with dull red flowers.
2. **Aloe Turkanensis** – is a shrub with stem up to 7 cm long. It grows in loose clumps up to 2 cm diameter. Leaves are born in compound rosette and are erect to spreading with the elongated whitish spots on both surfaces. The inflorescence is many branched up to 30 cm long and pink in colour.
3. **Aloe Rivaie** - is a stemless species growing solitary or in small clumps. Older plants have a stem up to 60 cm high. Leaves are born in dense rosette, erect or spreading and slantly recurved at the tips. The inflorescence is much branched and up to 75 cm high with bright yellow flowers.
4. **Secundiflora** – is a stemless species growing solitary or sometimes suckering. Older plant may have stems up to 30 cm long. The leaf spread and slightly recurved towards the tips. The inflorescence is 2 metres high, multi branch with bright red pink or yellow flowers. Secundiflora is the most commonly observed aloe species widely distributed in Kenya. It has high potential for medicinal properties

5. **Aloe vera Barbadensis**– is a world wide plant commonly with the same features and characteristics as Turkanensis. And its high potential for medicinal value. The leaves are born in compound rosette and are erect to spreading with a whitish colour on the leaves depending on the environment.

6. **Aloe vera chinensis**– is a stemless species and is a suckering plant well known for its medicinal value and does very well in tropical areas. The leaves are born combat rosette full of jelly and it is a well known plant for its medicinal value. The leaves are light green and produces bright yellow flowers.

We are in possession of the above mentioned aloe species but aloe vera chinensis being the much produced in our farm. We have a total acreage of about 15 acres and plant volume of about 35,000 seedling plants and about six species.

At the moment the availability of the aloe vera leaves is about 1 ton every week.

Today the Karibu presents KENYA FORGE OF TALENTS, a model that combines education and work, health and assistance, agriculture and commercial activities united in a single large space where everything is offered with care to those who want to change themselves and their country. No more need to emigrate where often he will have no future, but to stay where his origins are and contribute to the growth of his country.

To carry out this project, Karibu Onlus calls for close collaboration with those who are able to support it until the end and beyond.

The governments and large companies of the country are the forces that can perform this miracle: to ensure the country a large and solid base of education, work, health, agricultural, commercial and industrial development. Everywhere, starting from the poorest and most remote rural areas where isolated Kenyan citizens are in need of care and attention, always, not only in the period of the political elections.

The project Forge of Talents is available for the development of some of the rural and poor areas of Kenya. A development model dedicated above all to the youth of Kenya for the enhancement of the new generations but also for the assistance of adults and the elderly.

School, work, health, sport, social assistance and community integration will be the bases of the modular structure of the project whose prototype is nearing completion in Kibora in the Chakama area.

The FORGE OF TALENTS project involves the construction of 10 modules identical to the prototype model and located in various areas of the country, areas chosen among the poorest and those in need of help. The headquarters that will control the 10 modules will be in Nairobi and all the modules will refer to it, in turn independently managed according to the different territorial needs.

The administration and economic management of the project will be entrusted to a unit of the Ministry of the Interior. (MIFoTU)*

The first task of the government will be to create a Consortium (Community of Investors) of at least 10 major companies, primarily Kenyans, that can guarantee the necessary funding for the construction of the 10 modules and that will divide burdens and honors with the government.

Government will have to:

- 1- Choose 9 locations where to develop the module (the tenth is the prototype in Chakama).
- 2- Make available the land on which to build the module (100 acres for each model)
- 3- Provide the Scholastic Staff
- 4- Provide Healthcare Personnel
- 5- Provide and administer the General Headquarters in Nairobi.
- 6- Study tax breaks for the members of the Consortium.

Consortium

- 7- It will be the task of the Consortium to study and maintain a strategy to promote the project at national level and to obtain the consent and participation of the citizens through all the media channels.
 - 8- The consortium will have the possibility to insert an office / shop of each of its members / members in each of the 10 modules.
- In add, starting with the completion of the 10 models, it will fix an yearly prize of Ksh 1,000,000 for the best productive module.

Karibu Onlus

- 9- Karibu Onlus will be in charge to create all the 10 models and assist in the locations for 2 years from starting of the realization.
At the end of the period, the management of each module will pass to the local authorities under the guidance of the Government.
- 10- The Karibu Onlus guarantees the presence of a great Italian football team for the development of a FOOTBALL ACADEMY in each module.
- 11- Karibu Onlus will not receive any special remuneration due to its non-profit organization status while its managers and collaborators used for the realization of the modules and the two-year management period will be borne by the Consortium.

12- In each module there will be an office with control personnel of the Ministry of the Interior in contact with Nairobi Headquarters office and all news exchanges will take place in real time through a direct exclusive connection.
